RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF FOAM LAKE NO. 276

BYLAW NO 04-2013

A BYLAW RESPECTING THE BREAKING, PLOUGHING, CUTTING, FILLING, INJURING, ENCUMBERING, AND OBSTRUCTING OF ROADS AND OTHER PUBLIC PLACES

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Foam Lake No. 276 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. This bylaw shall be known as the "Unauthorized Road Work Bylaw".
2. In this bylaw:
 - a. The expression "municipal road" means any public highway that is under the direction, management, and control of a municipality pursuant to Section 12 of the Rural Municipalities Act 2005 and includes a road allowance.
3. No person shall plough, break, cut, fill, or otherwise injure a municipal road or other public place in the municipality except by written authority of the council.
4. No person shall destroy, break, cut, fill, or otherwise injure any vegetation on a municipal road or other public place in the municipality.
5. Any person who contravenes the provisions of this bylaw is guilty of an offense and liable on summary conviction to the penalties imposed in the General Penalty Bylaw of the Municipality.
6. Bylaw # 01-87 is hereby repealed.




