RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF FOAM LAKE NO. 276

BYLAW NO 04-2020

A BYLAW TO REGULATE VEHICLE WEIGHTS IN THE HAMLET OF TUFFNELL

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Foam Lake No. 276 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. In this bylaw:
 - a) "Administrator" shall mean the administrator of the municipality;
 - b) "Council" shall mean the council of the municipality; and
 - c) "Municipality" shall mean the Rural Municipality of Foam Lake No. 276
 - d) "Vehicle" means a motor vehicle as defined by or pursuant to *The Traffic Safety Act*.
 - e) "Tuffnell" shall mean the Hamlet of Tuffnell
2. Within the limits of Tuffnell no person shall operate a vehicle or a combination of vehicles or park on any street, when the combined gross weight of the vehicle(s) with or without a load exceeds 8,500kg, except on a roadway within the Municipality designated as a Heavy Vehicle Route.
3. Section (2) shall not apply to vehicles making deliveries, school buses, municipal equipment, non-licensed farm equipment for the purpose of servicing or fueling, or recreational vehicles on any roadway in the municipality provided that the operator of the vehicle(s) use the most direct route from and to the Heavy Vehicle Route.
4. Notwithstanding Section (3), the operator of the vehicles is responsible for any road damage caused when making such delivery.
5. The provisions of The Police Act and The Highways and Transportation Act, 1997 shall apply to the operators of the vehicles referred to in Sections (2) and (3).
6. This bylaw shall come into force on the date of approval by council.
