

BYLAW NO. 05-2018

RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF FOAM LAKE NO. 276

A bylaw to amend Bylaw No. 02-2017, known as the Zoning Bylaw.

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Foam Lake No. 276 in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts to amend Bylaw No. 02-2017 as follows:

1. Section 5.1.4 (a) is repealed and replaced with the following:

- a) Places of worship, cemeteries, and schools.

2. Section 5.2.5 (b) is repealed and replaced with the following:

- b) school dormitory or residences

3. Section 2.5 is amended by adding the following directly after 2.5.2:

2.5.3 All permits shall expire one year from the date of issuance and may be extended by Council for one additional year.

4. Section 2.13 is amended by adding the following directly after 2.13.6:

2.13.7 A record shall be maintained by the RM of all minor variance applications in accordance with *The Planning and Development Act, 2007*.

5. Table 3.14 is repealed and replaced with the following:

- Distances are measured between livestock facilities and building development
- Numbers in brackets apply where open liquid manure storage facilities are used or proposed
- Distances do not apply to residences associated with the operation

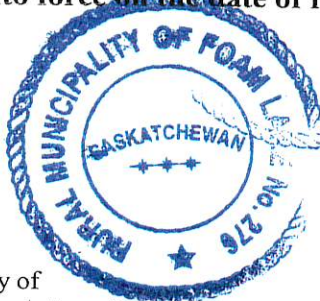
6. Section 3.25.2 (b) is repealed and replaced with the following:

b) A greater separation from residential development is required where open liquid manure storage facilities are used or proposed. Separation distances identified in Table 3.14 shall apply.

7. Section 3.52.2 (d) is repealed.

8. This bylaw shall come into force on the date of final approval by the Minister of Government Relations.
